

What follows should be viewed as an addendum to the existing behaviour policies in schools and a response to the current situation regarding the Covid19 virus and the behaviours we expect of students following their reintegration into the trust's schools.

Expectations in the classroom

- Students will use hand sanitiser each time they enter a classroom.
- Students may, under their teacher's direction, be permitted to use their mobile phone or other devices in the classroom to support access to online learning tasks. The Acceptable Use policy still applies, and mobile devices should not be used at break and lunchtimes.
- All classrooms will have socially distanced seating arrangements with designated desks for students. Students must sit in the seat they are allocated, using the same seat throughout the day.
- Students must remain in their allocated seat for the duration of the lesson, unless directed to move by a member of staff. If students need to move from their seat, they should ask permission from the teacher.
- Students should not approach the teacher's desk for any reason during the lesson.
- Desks and chairs must not be moved from their location.
- Stationery and equipment should not be shared.

Student expectations

- Arrive at school and leave to go home at the designated time. Do not congregate outside school in the morning or in school at the end of the day.
- Use hand sanitiser to disinfect hands on entering and leaving school.
- Wash hands with soap regularly for 20 seconds during the school day, especially after eating and after using the toilet.
- Follow guidance of 'Catch it, Bin It, Kill it' when coughing or sneezing and put any tissues immediately into a lidded bin.
- In accordance with social distancing, students should avoid physical contact with others at all times. This means maintaining a safe 2m distance from others between and during lessons, following signage around school and directions from staff.
- At break and lunchtimes, whether inside or outside the building, students will be supervised in designated areas and expected to follow social distancing.
- Students should not share belongings or food with others.
- Students should use the toilet block designated for their group. Two people are allowed to use the toilets, but only one at the sink at any one time.
- Students must follow the one way system around the school.

Expectations on Buses

- Students using school buses will only travel on the bus service allocated to them.
- If a student fails to produce a bus pass, they will not be able to travel on the bus.
- Students will distance themselves on the bus. Under no circumstances must they sit next to each other whilst travelling to and from school.
- Students need to remain in their seats for the duration of their journey and behave sensibly.
- In accordance with government guidelines relating to transport providers, the bus company will take responsibility for wiping down seats and railings. Students travelling on public transport must wear face masks.

Where the expectations outlined above are not adhered to, disciplinary sanctions will be applied in line with the school's behaviour policy.
