Arrangements for Christmas Lunches

The cost for the Christmas dinner will be £3.75 per student (this does not apply to students in receipt of free school meals).

- **Years 11, 12 & 13 - Friday 15th December**

Only the year groups allocated on each day can opt for a Christmas lunch; all other year groups can either purchase a sandwich or will need to bring a packed lunch. If your child is eligible for free school meals, they will receive a packed lunch on the days when they are not having a Christmas dinner.
